- 2. Acknowledgement of adoption of resolutions by the entity's Governing Body regarding Standards and Assessment Measures.*
- 3. List the exact Entity website internet link to the information specified in Article 3 as required by statute.*
- 4. Acknowledgement of requirement to deliver, upon request and within 30 days, to the Secretary of State its most recent Report.*
- 5. Acknowledgement of 3 specific commitments as required by statute.*
- 6. Delaware street address, including street name and number, city and zip code, of the address to which the Secretary of State shall mail any notice.*
- 7. Acknowledgement that declarations contained in the Statement of Adoption are true and correct.*
